- **Declaration**
A declaration that you will uphold the veterinary practitioners' code of professional conduct (Form 1D).
- **Photograph**
Your photograph (any size), which must be signed by you on the back.
- **Proof of Date of Birth****
A certified copy of your birth registration certificate (or if it is not available, other evidence of your age acceptable to the Board – for example, a driver's licence or passport).
- **Proof of Qualification****
A certified copy of any academic award (a translation of non English degree is required)(or if you cannot produce such a document, any other evidence of your qualification approved for the purpose by the Registrar).
- **Fees**
- **Letter of Professional Standing (LOPS)** – requested from current/last Board. If you have not practised as a veterinary practitioner since graduation or last registration you must submit a written statement confirming this.
- **Other Checklists** – see Form 1a, 1b or 1c to verify whether any other documents are required.
