

# Are your animals fit for transport?

An animal is NOT fit for transport if it is:

- not strong enough to undertake the journey
- unable to walk on its own by bearing weight on all legs
- emaciated, weak or visibly dehydrated
- suffering from visible distress or injury or disease
- blind in both eyes
- in late pregnancy

## If in doubt - leave it out!

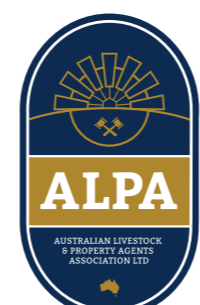
It is an offence in NSW to load animals that are not fit for the intended journey.
